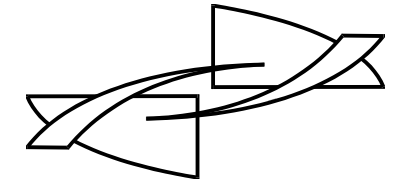

Preamble

The Vocational Schools I Uelzen (BBS I Uelzen) were established in 1832 and they are a barrier-free Environment School in Uelzen. True to the principal motto "Shaping the future together" we as a regional centre of competence are guided in the organization and in our school life by the German Sustainability Code (GSC). Sustainable development is a development that ensures the quality of life of the current generation and at the same time makes sure that future generations have the chance to shape their lives.

Sustainable education aims to develop the individual action and creativity competence of young people and young adults for a liveable future in a democratic society. This includes:

- social sustainability in terms of human rights, global responsibility and peaceful conflict resolution,
- environmental sustainability in the sense of preserving the natural environment for future generations,
- economic sustainability in terms of resource-saving economy.
